Good+Foundation is a nonprofit organization founded by Jessica Seinfeld in 2001 that addresses multi-generational poverty by leveraging the power of "goods" paired with transformational services to help low-income families move toward financial stability. Good+Foundation makes grants to programs that have demonstrated a capacity to improve family economic security in three areas: supporting new mothers, engaging fathers and early child development. The Foundation has a team of over 15 full-time staff with an annual operating budget of approximately \$2 million in cash and \$5M in product. The organization's main office is in the Garment District of NYC, with an office in Los Angeles, CA.

Good+Foundation is currently seeking a trainer to join the Good+ Training Academy team to provide virtual and/or in-person training (when safe to do so), offer technical assistance, and facilitate connections to resources in an effort to transform social service systems that have been identified as obstacles in helping families thrive.

The Good+ Training Academy seeks to increase the capacity of individuals and agencies who want to invest in utilizing a trauma-informed lens to successfully support fathers, mothers, and families. We've found these particular areas to be blind spots in the broader social sector, and we believe that providing high-quality training opportunities is essential to breaking down the systemic barriers that prevent the marginalization of many low-income families.

The ideal candidate should be a confident public speaker who is up-to-date on the latest tools and resources needed to provide training using both a trauma-informed lens and a Two-Generation (2Gen) approach that builds a family's well-being and promotes effective engagement.
